SANITARY MEASURE 2022-01
(Rescinding Sanitary Measure 2021-01, as updated April 14, 2022)

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2022, Governor Doug Ducey terminated the Declaration of Emergency that had been issued on March 11, 2020, to address the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) subsequently rescinded Emergency Measure 2022-01, which had required reporting of COVID-19 outbreaks in schools, child care establishments, and shelters; and

WHEREAS, the County's authority under A.R.S. § 36-788 to quarantine and isolate individuals or groups of people is dependent on the existence of a state of emergency or state of war emergency; and

WHEREAS, the reporting requirements adopted by the Pima County Health Department pursuant to A.R.S. § 36-624 in Sanitary Measure 2021-01 have therefore essentially been rendered moot;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Sanitary Measure 2021-01 is hereby rescinded.
