PROTECT YOURSELF BY GETTING VACCINATED

DID YOU KNOW?

- + The virus is very contagious, spreading person to person and causing an outbreak.
- + Hepatitis A can make you sick for weeks to months.
- + Some people have even died in this outbreak.
- + The vaccine is safe and effective. A single shot can prevent you from getting hepatitis A.

WHO SHOULD GET VACCINATED?

- + People who use or inject drugs.
- + People who have unstable housing or are homeless.
- + People who are or were recently in jail or prison.
- + Men who have sex with men.
- + People with liver disease, such as cirrhosis, hepatitis B, or hepatitis C.
