
The correct way to dispose of:

Needles and Syringes



1. Place needle in a puncture proof plastic container with a screw-on lid (e.g., detergent bottle)
2. Label the container "DO NOT RECYCLE"
3. Secure lid with duct tape
4. Dispose in a trash can DO NOT RECYCLE

Liquid Medications



1. Pour liquid medications into water-tight container (e.g. empty butter tub)
2. Mix in used coffee grounds, kitty litter or soil
3. Secure lid with duct tape
4. Dispose in a trash can DO NOT RECYCLE



Items labeled:

- Expired/unused/unwanted prescriptions



What's NOT Accepted

- Liquids
- Creams
- Household hazardous waste
- Inhalation/aerosol bottles
- Sharps
- Batteries
