- Consult Pima County Health Department

## PATIENT'S CLINICAL HISTORY AND EXPOSURES

PCHD will obtain patient's demographics, clinical history and possible exposures . And will consult with Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).



## SPECIMEN COLLECTION



Preferred specimen is at least 4mL whole blood with EDTA
