



Pima County Jail: Booking and Releases




Bookings = Individuals brought into jail/booked

 Comparison of baseline (1879) to December 2017: decrease of 2%


Pima County Jail: Pretrial vs Sentenced



October 2015 to December 2017 comparison:


- Pretrial decreased by ~.3%, and

Pima County Jail: Reported Average Length of Stay




October 2015 to October 2017 comparison: decrease of ~4%
