



Bookings = Individuals brought into jail/booked


## Pima County Jail: Average Daily Population

Comparison of baseline (1879) to January 2018: decrease of 3%


## Pima County Jail: Pretrial vs Sentenced



October 2015 to December 2017 comparison:


- Pretrial increased by 1.82%, and
