- A. Discussion of Projects that Fall in Group 2: Projects where the County Administrator and Subcommittees' recommendations are the same, but differ in funding allocations

The County Administrator will provide information on the reasons behind his current recommendations.

1. Group 2 – Subset A: Projects where the County Administrator recommended funding greater than the Subcommittees

There are a total of 9 projects that fall within this subset. The Subcommittees recommend a total of \$50,026,000 for Group 2 – Subset A projects, while the County Administrator recommends a total of \$65,450,000.

2. Group 2 – Subset B: Projects where the County Administrator recommended funding less than the Subcommittees

There are a total of 25 projects that fall within this subset. The Subcommittees recommend a total of \$583,638,570 for Group 2 – Subset B projects, while the County Administrator recommends a total of \$247,500,000.
